

Eighth Period


- In-school activity period Wednesdays & Fridays

Evidence of academic achievement in school



Demonstration of genuine interest/curiosity/ creativity in STEM

Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ 8th grade to apply to 9th
- ✓ Residency in a participating school division
- ✓ Honors Algebra I or higher in 8th Grade
- ✓ Along with Honors Science and One Additional Honors Course
- ✓ 3.5 GPA in core classes
 - Unweighted grades

Expectations If You Attend TJ

- <u>TJ Advanced Studies Diploma Requirements</u> English (4 credits), Math (4 credits that does not include Algebra 1), Lab Science (4 credits), History and Social Studies (4 credits), World Language (3 credits consecutive years in same language), Health & PE (2 credits), Fine Arts or Career & Tech Ed (1 credit), Economics & Personal Finance (1 credit), Electives (3 credits)
- <u>9th Grade Courses</u> IBEST (Biology, English, Statistics [1st Semester] and Math Placement [2nd Semester], Technology [Design & Tech]), Health & PE, World Language, Elective
- <u>Course Flexibility</u> Since the curriculum is a programmatic approach to STEM at a higher level, there is limited ability to deviate from the set coursework described above. See TJHSST link below for Course Planning Resources:

Steps for Application

- 1. The applicant must access the Log-In Screen prior to the parent and complete the initial log-in process that includes entry of a parent name and email address.
- 2. Parent receives an auto-generated email containing the link for them to log-in and create the parent account.
- TJ Liaison Counselor from applicant's school verifies math course. (Allow minimum 24 to 48 hours for this to be completed.) An autogenerated email is sent to applicant and parent after verification advising they may complete the application.

Steps for Application (Concluded)

- 4. Applicant and parent must both electronically sign.
- 5. Submit application.
- 6. Auto-generated email will be sent to applicant and parent advising them <u>application has been submitted.</u>
- 7. Be sure to check the calendar listed in this presentation for "What is next after submission of the application?"

Seat Allocation Process

 Each public school within Fairfax County and each cooperating school division will be presumptively allocated a number of seats equal to 1.5% of that school's 8th grade student population ("Allocated Seats"),. The remainder of seats will not be allocated to any specific public school ("Unallocated Seats"). In the event a school has fewer eligible applicants than its number of Allocated Seats, the difference will be treated as Unallocated Seats.

Seat Allocation Process

• Allocated Seats

- Applicants attending public school will be first evaluated against other applicants from the same school, and students with the strongest evaluated applications from that school will be offered admission.
- Unallocated Seats
 - All remaining public-school applicants and applicants who do not attend public school in Fairfax County or in a cooperating division will be considered for the Unallocated Seats, which will be offered to the highest evaluated applicants in that group.
