Our goal at Irving is to help each student reach his or her potential. For class selection, we encourage students to enroll in the most rigorous course in which they can be successful. We want our students to benefit from the rigor of our curriculum while experiencing a sense of accomplishment.

Parents/guardians are an important component of the decision-making process when it comes to identifying the best class for their child. We ask that parents discuss the options with their child and the child's teacher to determine which course will challenge their mind and at the same time maximize their learning. Please also consider the number of honors courses your child can handle as well as time commitments outside of school when making core selections.

Elementary teachers have provided their suggestions on the front of this sheet regarding the core class they believe your child should take next year. In the table below, we have provided some criteria to consider when determining whether an honors class is appropriate for your child.
