- Students learn to use language in the four domains of reading, writing, speaking and listening
- •ESOL course selection is based upon the English Language Proficiency Level of the individual student

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## **Assessments**

WIDA assessments are federally required in Virginia to measure students' English language proficiency levels.

- WIDA Screener: used to identify English Language Learners (ELLs) during registration
- •WIDA MODEL for Grades 1-12: used to identify English Language Learners (ELLs)
- ACCESS for ELLs: students are tested every school year during January – March
