ESOL Classes



- Fully aligned to the grade level Standards of Learning
- Instruction provides English Learners with a language focused environment to develop the academic language
- Students learn to use language in the four domains of **reading, writing, speaking** and **listening**
- ESOL course selection is based upon the English Language Proficiency Level of the individual student

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Assessments

WIDA assessments are federally required in Virginia to measure students' English language proficiency levels.

- WIDA Screener: used to identify English Language Learners (ELLs) during registration
- WIDA MODEL for Grades 1-12: used to identify English Language Learners (ELLs)
- ACCESS for ELLs: students are tested every school year during January – March
